

QUALIFICATION CREDIT FRAMEWORK (QCF)

The Level 2 and Level 3 Diploma in Health and Social Care (Adults) comprises of a number of mandatory and optional units agreed upon by the learner, employer and tutor .

The qualification aims to guide and assess the development of knowledge and skills relating to the health and social care workforce

CERTIFICATE IN PREPARING TO WORK IN ADULT SOCIAL CARE (LEVEL 2 AND LEVEL 3)

This qualification consists of 9 units. This qualification relates to the knowledge elements of the Diploma and forms the knowledge component of the Health and Social Care Apprenticeship Framework.

EMPLOYMENT RIGHTS AND RESPONSIBILITIES (LEVEL 2)

This one unit award covers the Employment Responsibilities and Rights in Health, Social Care and Children and Young Peoples settings and includes:
